(SIUC) Southern Illinois University Carbondale announced how they will be using their AIM HIGH GRANT money. SIUC will increase the value of the Dean's Scholarship for freshman by \$2,000. Students who qualify for the Dean's \$4,000 will now be offered \$6,000 and students who qualify for the Dean's \$6,000 will now be offered \$8,000.
